According to recent City reports, one in five families reside in substandard living conditions, with 76,000 of them waiting up to 10 years or more for some form of social housing.

The problem of providing simple, decent, affordable housing is clear. With your support, we are contributing to the solution.

This year, Habitat for Humanity Toronto had 52 new homes under construction, with a goal to add at least 50 completed homes per year by 2015. These numbers provide measurable benefits not only to our Partner Families, but to our city as a whole — through homeownership, Habitat Partner Families contributed over \$450,000 in tax revenue to Toronto in 2011!

We can celebrate these successes only by way of our supporters. TREB's continued support has born fruit — and for that, we thank you so much.

We are making great strides toward eliminating poverty housing in Toronto, but there is still work to be done. As we press forward to meet our goals by 2015, we are looking forward to your continued partnership with us.



The Matin children brought home better grades to help build their new Habitat home by earning "sweat equity" as a way to contribute to their parents' partnership with Habitat Toronto. Everyone in the Matin family is excited to have a safe and decent home that has plenty of space for studying and playing. "Before Habitat, our life was very difficult," Merajuddin explains. "We're six people who were living in a small, two-bedroom apartment. Our children couldn't study or sleep properly because of the overcrowding."

Like their children, Merajuddin and his wife, Saiedah, aren't just moving into a new home – they're helping build one. "We were involved in each stage of the homebuilding process with Habitat. I love dedicating my time to activities that help build affordable homes for low-income families." For the Matin family, a new home means more than a brighter future for their children. It's a new start for other families just like them. "Home is a place where you live comfortably and safely. It's a place you enjoy filling with family and friends."
